Your stay

At your private site:

- · Outdoor fire pit and grill
- · Picnic table and seats
- Outhouses
- · Bed and pillows
- · Electric lights and heating
- · Cookware and utensils (not included in Hazelnuts #24, #25, #26)

Included in your stay:

- · Access to WiFi (at the reception area)
- Access to central shower block
- · Water for dishes (10L total)
- · Access to power to charge small personal appliances (at the reception area)
- Toilet paper

Please bring with you:

- · Appropriate clothing and footwear (we're in the · Flashlight (this is camping, it can get dark) forest!)
- Your own towel/biodegradable body soap
- Food + Cooler + Ice (there is no refrigeration)
- · Sheets, blankets, and pillowcases (or rent for \$25 + tax
- Cookware and utensils (for Hazelnuts #24, #25, #26)
- · Can opener, bottle opener, corkscrew
- · Bug Spray/mosquito netting
- Camping stove and fuel (for Hazelnuts #24, #25, #26)

Vacation center rules and park regulations:

- · Do not feed the wildlife
- · Do not make fires outside of designated fire areas
- · Do not walk off trails
- · Do not pick mushrooms and/or other flora
- · Respect common spaces and leave areas cleaner than when you entered them
- Use the outhouses and make sure to urinate at least 50ft from water
- · Quiet hours are enforced between 10pm and 7am
- Food waste and garbage must be disposed of in designated areas
- · Pets are required to be on a leash at all times and owners must clean up after their pets. Any guest with a pet that creates a noise nuisance will be asked to remove the pet from the property
- · Gathering and cutting wood is strictly prohibited. Firewood is for sale at each unit. Please do not bring your own wood to prevent the spread of diseases
- Food and toiletries must be stored in a secure location out of reach of animals
- NO CANDLES PLEASE. Fire can catch easily on a spilt candle. Electric torches are much safer.

Getting to Terra Perma and Checking in




